Figures and Tables

Figures and tables should be numbered. Figures and tables (including captions) should be centered.

You can place narrow figures and tables (including captions) on the left side or the right side of the page and fill the remaining space with text.

Figure captions should be placed at the bottom of the figure and table captions should be placed at the top of the table.

Also, please reduce the bit depth (colour quality) and resolution of the figures to keep the file size to a manageable level.

Please do not incorporate rotated pictures or rotated tables.

Equations

All equations should be centered and numbered. Please use Microsoft® Equation 2.0 or 3.0.

$$X(t) = \sum_{i=1}^n \left( \frac{a_i^2}{b_i} \sqrt{c_i} \right) e^{\frac{-b}{t}} \quad (1)$$

We suggest setting a tab-stop at 7.0 cm with centre alignment and a tab-stop at 15.0 cm with right alignment.
