- 1. The possession or use of alcohol and non-therapeutic drugs is strictly forbidden.
- 2. Smoking is strictly prohibited and against the law for those under the age of 18.
- 3. Tampering with or damage to UF property is strictly forbidden and charges will be levied for repair or replacement.
- 4. Students are expected to respect and follow class assignment and attendance policies. 5. Students may not leave campus during the program, unless accompanied by a counselor or in the company of an individual approved by their parent/guardian. Parents must notify the office 24 hours in advance for students to leave campus with anyone outside their immediate family. If a student is leaving campus, their counselor must be notified in advance and must meet the parent/guardian/friend before they leave campus together.
- 6. For the safety of our students, our staff must know where each student is at all times. Students must check in with their counselors at designated times throughout the day and must remain at all times, not only within the bound of the campus, but in specific designated areas.
- 7. All students must adhere to quiet hours between 10pm-7am and lights out at 11pm. 8. We prefer socializing and cooperative activities to take place in the common spaces of the dormitory; however, if students choose to invite friends from the program into their rooms to socialize, the door must be propped open. 9. Students must attend all classes and scheduled evening and weekend events (some events are optional). If you are ill, your counselor must be notified; depending on the severity of your illness, your counselor may decide to stay remain dorm with you so you may rest in your room. 10. Cell phone use is not allowed during classes or evening events.
